CO-OP Application

"CO-OP" (Cooperative Education or Applied Training in Industry) is an education model based on the cooperation between the University and the business world and requires the student to work in a company or institution during undergraduate education. With this application, our students step into the process of experiencing what they learn in the classroom in the field by working in the industry and companies they are interested in for 14 weeks (1 semester).

CO-OP application is carried out in organizations that students apply with their own efforts as well as the support of our department and university.

Our students who graduate after the CO-OP application can then get employment opportunities in the company where they did CO-OP.

Tübitak Smart Bigg Program

Within the scope of the TUBITAK Smart BIGG program, where Hasan Kalyoncu University is the Implementing Institution, our students with innovation-oriented initiative ideas receive 200 thousand TL grant support if they pass the necessary stages.

Within the framework of the program, Entrepreneurship Training, Prototyping and Mentoring support is provided.

Experienced mentors provide technical, commercial and administrative support to the entrepreneur.

They are provided with business model and business plan preparation trainings.
